

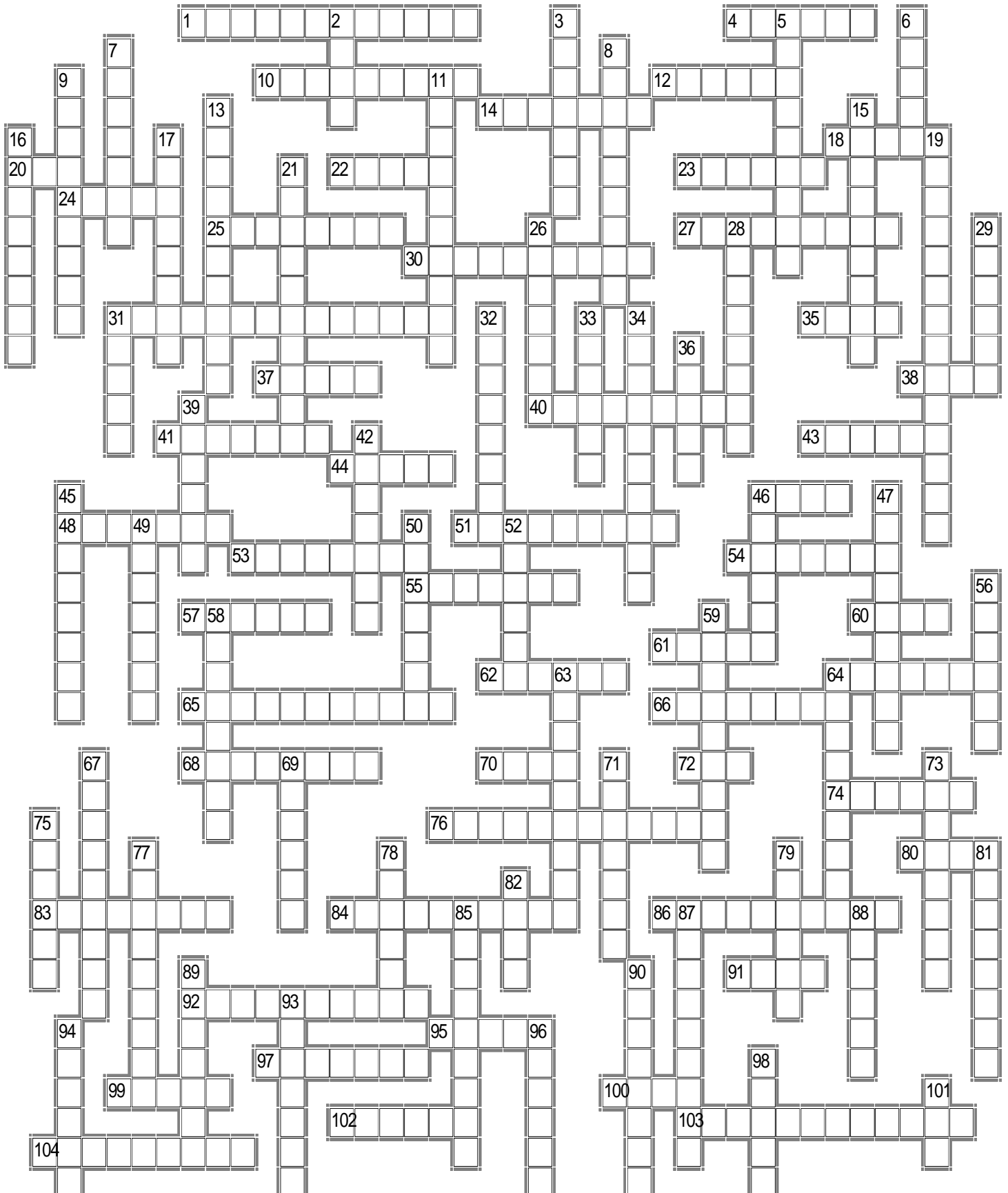


Films of the 20th Century

Between 26th July and the 22nd August a group of 20 students from Malmesbury School will be travelling to a remote part of Southern India to help in the construction of eco-sanitation units for villagers who do not currently have access to basic hygienic sanitation facilities in order to provide a sustainable solution. The Malmesbury students will assist each family in the village to construct their own eco-sanitation facility - a composting toilet. The project will improve villagers' health through increasing access to safe drinking water in the community by reducing pollution of the local water sources.
